



Information and Terms

1- Organization and objectives

- 1.1- The Águas d'Alte Tour, with optional lunch at the Alte Professional School, is an event promoted and organized by the Alte Professional School and will take place on March 15, 2026;
- 1.2 - The Alte Professional School is an institution whose mission is to pursue objectives of public interest. This event promotes awareness of the importance of regular physical exercise and aims to raise funds for the school.

2- Points of interest along the route

2.1 - The route takes place in the heart of the UNESCO Global Geopark, called Algarvensis . Alte is a good testament to the geological history of the planet. For example, the volcanic rocks and ash on two of its slopes bear witness to the large-scale eruptions that occurred at the end of the Triassic period, about 201 million years ago, associated with the separation of the then supercontinent Pangaea, which would give rise to the opening of the Atlantic Ocean and the continents we know today;

- 2.2 - A lunch bag containing local products will be provided at the start of the tour;
- 2.3 - At the end of the tour there will be an "optional" lunch at the Alte Professional School;

2.4 - Other points of interest highlighted:

- The Alte River ecosystem with its watermills and washhouses. The Alte stream is itself a geological feature, being a discharge area for the largest underground aquifer in the Algarve;

Vicar's Waterfall;

- Fonte Grande and Fonte Pequena springs;
- Spotters of Olho de Boi and Fonte Pequena;
- Fauna and Flora of the Barrocal;

3 - Route characteristics

- 3.1- The route of the tour will be close to the Alte River, the surrounding area and in the village of Alte itself, covering a distance of approximately 10 km;
- 3.2 - It is a circular route with the starting and ending point at the Alte Professional School;
- 3.3 - The route is generally easy, however there are some parts with slightly uneven terrain and some changes in elevation;
- 3.4 - The tour will begin at 9:00 AM and will be guided;
- 3.5 – The tour has an estimated duration of 3 hours;
- 3.6 – It is recommended to bring a change of shoes to change into at the end, as you will be crossing small streams;
- 3.7 - Not wheelchair accessible.

4- Participants

- 4.1 - Everyone can participate regardless of age;
- 4.2 - All children must be accompanied by an adult.

5- Registration

- 5.1 - The tour has a limit of 30 participants;
- 5.2 - Registrations will be conducted exclusively online at www.acorrer.br;
- 5.3 - The registration period ends on March 12, 2026, or when the limit of paid registrations is reached;
- 5.4 - All participants , or their guardians in the case of minors under 18 years of age, must read the regulations beforehand, as registration implies full acceptance of its terms;
- 5.5 - The registration fee for the Guided Walking Tour is R\$ 11.00 without lunch. The cost of lunch, which is optional, at the Alte Professional School, is €15.00;
- 5.6 – The registration fee includes:
 - Guided Tour;
 - Lunch – Cornmeal porridge with fried fish/fried meat, for those who select this option;
 - A bag (snack bag) with local products to take at the beginning of the tour;
 - Personal accident insurance (see point 7).
- 5.7 - Registrations will only be validated after the respective payment has been made;
- 5.8 - Payments made after the due date will not be considered. In such cases, refunds will be made by bank transfer, deducting the respective bank charges.



6- Payment Method

- 6.1 - By MB, MBway , Bizum or Credit Card following the instructions in the Acorrer registration report;
- 6.2 - At the office of the Cândido Guerreiro Professional School in Alte;
- 6.3 - For payments outside of Portugal, contact geral@acorrer.pt.

7- Insurance

- 7.1 - All participants are covered by personal accident insurance;
- 7.2 - The insurance policy will have a deductible of R\$ 60.00 for treatment and repatriation expenses and a 10% deductible for permanent disability coverage;
- 7.3 - Any accident or incident that occurs during the course of the course is the responsibility of the participants, for all amounts exceeding the risk covered by the insurance. This insurance coverage only applies in the event of an accident.

8- Security

- 8.1 - The route is open to other vehicles, therefore all participants must respect traffic laws. The organization is not responsible for any accident or traffic violation committed by any participant.
- 8.2 - By registering, the participant assumes full responsibility for ensuring they meet the physical and psychological conditions to participate;
- 8.3 - It is recommended to wear appropriate clothing and footwear and to carry a water container;
- 8.4 - Participants should never lose sight of one of the guides.

9- Image Rights

The participant grants permission to the organizing entity to use their image, recorded on photographic or video media, or any other means, for promotional and advertising purposes of the event itself and the organizing entity.

10-Social and environmental duties

- 10.1 - To assist any participant in case of an accident, provided that the circumstances require it;
- 10.2 - Do not cause damage to private or cultivated areas;
- 10.3 - The organization appeals to all participants not to leave empty packaging along the route. They should dispose of it strictly in the trash containers.



11- Data protection

11.1 - By registering, all participants authorize the publication of their personal data necessary for the development of the tour, such as for the insurance list, as well as its use for sending information related to the event, including subsequent editions;

11.2 - Each participant is responsible for the accuracy of the data provided in their registration, and is aware that this data will be part of a file for which the organization will be responsible;

11.3 - The data subject shall have the right to access, rectify and erase this data, as determined by the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).

12- Omissions

12.1 - Any matters not covered by these regulations shall be decided by the organization in accordance with applicable legal and regulatory standards;

12.2 - Due to unforeseen circumstances, the organization reserves the right to make changes to these Regulations, and they will always be updated on the event website.
